POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION GRANT

The vision of NGAW is to Amplify the Voice of Every Guardsman. We seek to make what you want a reality by lobbying on your behalf. Over the last few years, one piece of legislation we've worked very hard to secure is the Post-Secondary Education Grant. This grant helps pay tuition and fees not covered by traditional financial aid. YOUR STATE SPONSORED LIFE INSURANCE

We know it's a morbid topic, but have you thought about your life insurance coverage? Did you realize that all actively serving Washington National Guard members, both Army and Air, are automatically enrolled in a State Sponsored Life Insurance (SSLI) program? You are! No application is necessary. Washington is part of a 23 state "association pool" that is currently insured by the Armed Forced Benefits Association (AFBA).

The Basic program provides \$1000 coverage in the event of death. It also provides coverage for your spouse and/or dependents, and additional Enhanced coverage can be added at any time while you are a WANG member. Death benefits are paid directly to the beneficiary on policy within 24 hours.



Benefits Architects from the SSLI organization regularly administer a brief about the program to Washington Solders and Airman, trying to get to every unit every 18-24 months. Have they visited your unit recently? Did you realize you had this fantastic coverage?
