### **2023 SCHOLARSHIPS**

The application window for our 2023 scholarships is open! NGAW members and their immediate dependents are eligible for a variety of scholarships offered by NGAW, the NGAW Foundation and USAA (Enlisted only), with awards starting at \$500. Last year we awarded \$6000 in scholarships to our members and their dependents!

Applicants must be a current paid or lifetime member of NGAW or the dependent of a current or lifetime member (Officer, Enlisted, or Retiree). Applicants must submit an essay and two letters of recommendation.

For current Guardsmen, one letter must come from the Unit Commander or the First Sergeant. All applications must be submitted by the May 5, 2023 deadline. Recipients will be announced at the State Conference on May 13. Those not present at the conference will be notified the following week.

### **MARCH 2023 CAPITOL SUMMIT**

Last month, NGAW selected me to represent Washington State at the March 2023 NGAUS Capitol Summit in DC. The Summit is a professional development opportunity for Army and Air National Guard company-grade officers and warrant officers (CGOs). It is a very fast paced weekend with a lot of information and briefings fit in —a firehose of information delivered by the best of lecturers. Events ranged from history lessons on the National Guard, to bus tours, to speaking directly with Congressional Staff about the challenges facing our Soldiers. All while surrounded by highly motivated CGOs from all the States and Territories of the USA.

I was there to represent, and I was hungry to see how the system works. I imagined the Summit would be a rundown of the National Guard Bureau and how we, as SMs, fit into the DoD and the Federal Government. It was so much more.

My highlights from the Summit include:

- 1. The focus on, and exposure to, the history and legacy of the National Guard. MG (ret.) Dunbar gave a complete history on the Guard in a little over an hour and filled in many holes I did not realize I missed.
- 2. The awareness of where the modern Guard, and the DoD, sit in the world. The Deputy Director of the ANG, Maj Gen Pirak, briefed us on the Guard's expanding role in the developing tensions in the world and the problems we are uniquely equipped to deal with.
- 3. The extent to which DC runs on relationships and reputation. I knew that mattered, but I was blown away by how important it is to have motivated team players working through the system.



4. ARNG is THE Combat Reserve of the Regular Army. The Deputy Director of the ARNG, MG Andonie, emphasized the continuing need for a fully functional, interoperable, and modernized ARNG to effectively serve as the combat reserve for the RA.

I love being a member of the Guard and have spent time educating myself about the history and different aspects of it. But this experience, participating in this conference, having the opportunity to hear directly from senior leaders on where the organization is headed, meeting so many amazing peers from around the country, and advocating for our SMs realigned my perspective on the Guard and my place in it.

Our world really is small enough for everyone to make a significant difference, and groups such as NGAW and NGAUS are amazing opportunities to stay invested, involved, and participate in the evolution of our organization.


