Camp Murray Beach Campground Policies

Our campground is for DoD ID card holders ONLY.

The Camp Murray Campground is a traditional campground, not a residential campground, and long-term reservations are not allowed. We also do not offer RV storage, and guests are expected to stay with their RV overnight. Abandoned RVs are subject to removal by Security.

RV/Camping Rules

- 1. Fees for camping/RV hook-up are based on a family rate (adults and children). All fees are payable in advance through the online guest portal, at the NGAW office (Bldg. 2) during normal work hours, by phone, or by using the registration envelopes at the beach office.
- 2. Camping/RV set-up allowed in designated areas only.
- 3. The maximum RV stay is 30 days. After your 30 day stay you will be required to leave the campground, not just the particular site, for at least 3 days.
- 4. You may only make a new 30 day reservation after you have departed the campground for those 3 days.
- 5. Tent sites have a maximum stay of 14 days and will be required to depart for 14 days following the reservation.
- 6. Mid-stay changes to reservations are not allowed.
- 7. Guests are allowed to connect to the power hook-up at their site only. Connecting to outlets at adjacent sites is not allowed. All extensions cords need to be clearly marked to prevent injury to other campers.
- 8. Sewer hoses MUST utilize sealed connection at sewer hook-up. Disposal of diapers or anything other than toilet paper into the sewer system is prohibited.
- 9. Parking at your site is permitted as long as traffic through the park and to neighboring sites is unobstructed. Two vehicles are allowed per site, additional vehicles must be parked in the overflow area. Boat trailers must be parked in the Boat Launch area and may not be parked at the campsite.
- 10. RV sites may be vacated for specified periods of time to allow ground maintenance around vehicles. Management will not be responsible for damage to vehicles by flying rocks etc., if vehicles are not moved as requested.
- 11. Portable pet kennels are allowed, provided they do not encroach on another site or common area.
- 12. RV and campsites will be clean and presentable at all times, no garbage or disposal items shall accumulate at your site. Tarps are allowed in RV sites only for emergency repairs. A site not properly maintained will be subject to a \$15.00 fine.

- 13. Cutting/destruction of natural vegetation in the beach/camping area is prohibited. Non-beach/campground areas are off limits, except designated walking and running trails.
- 14. Immediately report any hazardous spills to Camp Host/Assistant Host. Changing automotive fluids at the campground is prohibited. Violators will be financially responsible for environmental clean up.
- 15. Check in time is at 12:00pm and check out time is at 11:00am. Enjoy your visit and please come again.
- 16. In an emergency or heightened security, the Washington Military Department (WMD) may evacuate the campground.
- 17. Both the Camp Host and Camp Murray Security are authorized to evict any persons/groups without refund who violate rules or engage in other improper activities.

General Use Policies

- 1. Campers and guests must comply with all state and federal laws governing Camp Murray, as well as all beach and dock area rules and regulations.
- 2. Noise must be kept to a minimum between the hours of 2200 and 0700.
- 3. Please observe the 5 MPH speed limit at all times. Repeat speeding violators will be asked to park alongside the fence at \$5.00 a day.
- 4. All parking must be in designated areas only, (see fee schedule for additional vehicle charges.)
- 5. Boat launch and moorage is free for registered campground guests. Day-use guests must pay the \$5 boat launch fee. All boat launch fees must be paid in advance. Boat launch fees are paid on the honor system. Day use of the beach ends at dusk.
- 6. Only vehicles with boat trailers are permitted in the boat ramp area. Parked vehicles/trailers must not obstruct others launching/retrieving boats.
- 7. Off road vehicles are not permitted anywhere on Camp Murray. Bicycles may be ridden only on established roadways.
- 8. All persons on bikes MUST wear a helmet.
- 9. Children under the age of 14 must have adult supervision.
- 10. Pet(s) must remain on a leash at all times and be supervised by an adult. You must clean up after your pet. Failure to do so will result in possible eviction.
- 11. Pets are not allowed in restrooms or the laundry room.
- 12. Staff may impound or remove any stray or unattended animal at the owner's expense.
- 13. There is no smoking within 25 feet of all public buildings.

- 14. There is no lifeguard on duty, swimming and boating are at your own risk.
- 15. Glass beverage containers are not allowed in the beach/picnic area. Alcohol is not allowed away from your campsite.
- 16. Firearms are prohibited for guests at the Camp Murray Campground other than WMD/National Guard employees with an approved exception. [policy updated Feb 2023 per Office of WAARNG Provost Marshal]
- 17. Fireworks/pyrotechnics are strictly prohibited on Camp Murray.
- 18. The use of Marijuana at the campground is prohibited at the Camp Murray Campground. [policy updated Feb 2023 per Office of the WAARNG Provost Marshal]
- 19. The use of unmanned aircraft systems (UAS) is prohibited at the Camp Murray Campground without prior approval from the Provost Marshal.
