In March, Holly Hansen from the 141 Air Refueling Wing, was encouraged by her leadership to pursue attending the NGAUS Spring Capitol Summit. The event, which was held at the National Guard Memorial, the association's headquarters in Washington, D.C., featured speakers from the NGAUS legislative team, lawmakers and senior military leaders.
