CALL TO ACTION: GI BILL PARITY ACT OF 2024

All NGAW members are urged to take action today by asking our Washington legislators in DC to support **HB 7543** and **S 3873** — **the GI Bill Parity Act of 2024**. These bills propose to amend title 38, United States Code, to expand eligibility for Post-9/11 Educational Assistance to members of the National Guard who perform certain full-time duty. This ensures that Guard Members and Reservists receive credit for every day they spend in uniform in a federal duty status under Titles 10 or 32 for GI Bill purposes, putting higher education within the reach of millions of veterans.

NGAW is a voice to advocate for the Guard Family by providing a platform for action. Taking action by asking your legislators to support these bills helps *all* members of the Guard family.
