LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

The Legislative Committee has been working hard! The 2025 Washington State Legislative Session convened on January 13, and this "long session" will adjourn on April 27. Watch for *Call to Action* emails from NGAW, which will encourage you to contact your legislators and encourage them to support the bills that would have an impact on the lives of our Washington service members and their families. Your voice matters and it's powerful! Our elected officials need to hear from you!

Last year, we helped pass a number of significant, military-related pieces of state legislation, including HB 1943, which expands the Guard Education Grant to spouses and dependent children, as well as SB 5803 and

HB 1869, regarding Guard Referral & Bonuses.

We also helped pass the following legislation:

HB 1862 Disabled Veteran Assist./tax

HB 1917 Physician Assistant Compact

HB 1939 Social Work Compact

HB 1943 National Guard Grant

HB 2004 Military Student Early Registration

HB 2111 Subsidized Child Care

SB 5803 National Guard Recruitment



Our top Priority Bills for this current session are:

HB 1073 – Keeping our Washington National Guard Strong Act.

HB 1016 – Providing employer tax incentives for the support of veterans and military families.

HB 1335 – Protecting military spouses from employment discrimination.

2025 SCHOLARSHIPS

Applications for our 2025 Scholarships will open on **March 1**, so start gathering your two letters of recommendation now! NGAW members and their dependents are eligible for a variety of scholarships offered by NGAW, the NGAW Foundation, and USAA (enlisted only), with awards starting at \$500. Last year we awarded over \$11,000 in scholarships to our members and their dependents!

Our scholarships are available for Soldiers and Airmen, Officers and Enlisted, members and their dependents. Applicants must be a current paid or lifetime member of NGAW or the dependent of a current or lifetime member. Applicants must submit an essay and two letters of recommendation. For current Guardsmen, one letter must come from your Unit Commander or First Sergeant. All applications must be submitted by the April 15, 2025 deadline. Recipients will be announced by the end of April, and the scholarships will be presented at our State Conference on May 17.
