








Downtown Milwaukee Map






Transportation

As our hotel is east of the river, we will also have complimentary bus transportation to and from the Baird Center.




You can also walk to the Baird Center, either on the street level or through Milwaukee's 1.75-mile SKYWALK system.

The skywalk network is managed by various property owners. Therefore, weekend and evening hours vary from connection to connection. However, the entire system is navigable Monday through Friday from 7:30 am to 5:30 pm.


