LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

The Washington State legislative session kicked-off on January 10th and will continue until March 12th. Your Washington State Legislature will continue to advance a wide range of proposals focused on improving economic opportunity, housing stability, education access, civic participation, and long-term support for Military members, their families, and Veterans alike. The NGAW Legislative Team has been working closely with the Veterans Legislative Coalition (VLC), Washington Department of Veterans Affairs (WDVA), the Washington Military Department, as well as State Legislators to ensure your voices are heard through strength and accurate discourse.

Key areas of legislation include:

- Employment & Economic Opportunity: Proposals include employer tax credits for hiring veterans and military spouses, protections against employment discrimination, expanded veteran job training and reentry programs, as well as initiatives supporting veteran-owned businesses.
- Housing & Property Tax Relief: Several bills aim to reduce housing costs through down payment assistance, adaptive housing tax preferences, property tax exemptions, and valuation freezes for disabled veterans, seniors, and military families.
- Education & Military Families: Legislation promotes education stability for children of military families, expands access to early learning programs, provides tuition waivers and grants for dependents and survivors, and supports on-base school construction efforts.
- National Guard Retention & Military Justice: Measures include the create of a Washington National Guard retention program, updates to the Washington Uniformed Code of Military Justice to strengthen victim protections, and formal recognition projects such as a Global War on Terror Memorial.
- Voting and Civic Engagement: Bills would expand secure electronic ballot access for service members, overseas and disabled voters, and improve coordination with tribal governments to ensure full participation in elections.
- Veterans Benefits & Governance: Additional proposals ensure continued access to State benefits and updates the structure of Veterans advisory bodies.
- Capabilities: As we advance into the future with current and emerging threats – counter unmanned aerial systems (cUAS) are emphasized in emerging legislation as widely available and dangerous drones pose a risk to public safety.

Many of these bills have upcoming hearings or are actively moving through committee in the interest of supporting Washington's Military and Veteran communities. NGAW will continue monitoring, educating, and aiding advocating efforts closely. Further ensuring that these policies strengthen readiness, retention, and quality of life for our service members and their families.

On Jan. 28, 2026, a distinct group of Air and Army Washington National Guard members, participated in the 2026 Legislative Day at the Washington State Legislature. This event aligned with the annual recognition of Washington Army and Air National Guard Day (officially observed on January 26 under state law), which honors the service and contributions of National Guard members in the state.

During the visit to the House and Senate, our representatives, including Senior Enlisted Leader Washington National Guard Allan Lawson and NGAW Legislative Director Sophia Wahto, had the opportunity to observe live Senate voting, meet Senators off of the floor, and gain valuable insight into the legislative process.



Understanding how legislation is developed and enacted is essential to effectively advocate for military members, their families, and veterans, ensuring their needs and concerns are accurately represented. Overall, the experience was highly educational and provided a valuable opportunity to represent the National Guard while deepening our understanding of State government.



2026 SCHOLARSHIPS

The application for our 2026 Scholarships will open on March 1! NGAW members and their dependents are eligible for a variety of scholarships offered by NGAW, the NGAW Foundation, and USAA (enlisted only), with awards starting at \$500. Last year we awarded over \$8,000 in scholarships to our members and their dependents!

Our scholarships are available for Soldiers and Airmen, Officers and Enlisted, members and their dependents. Applicants must be a current or lifetime member of NGAW or the dependent of a current or lifetime member. Applicants must submit an essay and two letters of recommendation. For current Guardsmen, one letter must come from your Unit Commander or First Sergeant. All applications must be submitted by the **April 15, 2026** deadline. Recipients will be announced prior to our State Conference.
