

Camp Murray Beach Campground Policies

Our campground is for DoD ID card holders ONLY.

The Camp Murray Campground is a traditional campground, not a residential campground, and long-term reservations are not allowed. We also do not offer RV storage, and guests are expected to stay with their RV overnight. Abandoned RVs are subject to removal by Security.

RV Rules

- 1. Cancellations of your reservations must be made 24 hours prior to the start of your reservation, or a one-night charge will be incurred. Changes mid-reservation will incur one additional night's charge and the remaining unused time will be refunded.**
2. Check in time is at 12:00pm and check out time is at 11:00am. Enjoy your visit and please come again.
3. Fees for camping/RV hook-up are based on a family rate (adults and children). All fees are payable in advance through the online guest portal or at the NGAW office (Bldg. 2) during normal work hours.
4. RV set-up allowed in designated areas only. Currently no tent camping is allowed.
5. After staying 21 total days (in any month), you must vacate the campground, not just the RV site, until the new month begins. There must be at least a 3-day gap between reservations. New reservations cannot be made until you've completed our current reservation.
6. Guests are allowed to connect to the power hook-up at their site only. Connecting to outlets at adjacent sites is not allowed. All extension cords need to be clearly marked to prevent injury to other campers. You will be charged one night's stay if found connecting your electric vehicle to another power pedestal.
7. Sewer hoses MUST utilize sealed connection at sewer hook-up. Disposal of diapers or anything other than toilet paper into the sewer system is prohibited.
8. Parking at your site is permitted as long as traffic through the park and to neighboring sites is unobstructed. Two vehicles are allowed per site; additional vehicles must be parked

in the overflow area up along the fence (additional \$5.00 nightly vehicle fee. Boat trailers must be parked in the Boat Launch area and may not be parked at the campsite.

9. RV will be clean and presentable at all times; no garbage or disposal items shall accumulate at your site. Tarps are allowed in RV sites only for emergency repairs. A site not properly maintained will be subject to a \$15.00 fine.

10. RV sites may be vacated for specified periods of time to allow ground maintenance around vehicles. Management will not be responsible for damage to vehicles by flying rocks etc., if vehicles are not moved as requested.

11. Cutting/destruction of natural vegetation in the beach/camping area is prohibited. Non beach/campground areas are off limits, except designated walking and running trails.

12. Immediately report any hazardous spills to Camp Host/Assistant Host. Changing automotive fluids at the campground is prohibited. Violators will be financially responsible for environmental cleanup.

13. In an emergency or heightened security, the Washington Military Department (WMD) may evacuate the campground.

14. Both the Camp Host and Camp Murray Security are authorized to evict any people/group without refund who violate rules or engage in other improper activities.

15. Your site will be checked upon Check-out and any trash left behind, to include any items left in the firepits (yes even paper), will incur a \$15.00 site clean-up fee.

General Use Policies

1. Campers and guests must comply with all state and federal laws governing Camp Murray, as well as all beach and dock area rules and regulations.

2. Noise must be kept to a minimum between the hours of 2200 and 0700 Sunday – Thursday and 2300-0800 Friday - Saturday.

3. Please always observe the 5 MPH speed limit. Repeat speeding violators asked to vacate the park and reported to the Provost Marshalls Office.

4. All parking must be in designated areas only, (see fee schedule for additional vehicle charges.)

5. Boat launch and moorage is free for registered campground guests. Day-use guests must pay the \$5 boat launch fee. All boat launch fees must be paid in advance. Boat launch fees are paid on the honor system. Day use of the beach ends at dusk.

6. Only vehicles with boat trailers are permitted in the boat ramp area. Parked vehicles/trailers must not obstruct others from launching/retrieving boats.
7. Off road vehicles are not permitted anywhere on Camp Murray. Bicycles may be ridden only on established roadways.
8. Children under the age of 12 must have adult supervision when outside of the RV.
9. There is no smoking within 25 feet of all public buildings.
10. There is no lifeguard on duty, swimming and boating are at your own risk.
11. Glass beverage containers are not allowed in the beach/picnic area. Alcohol is not allowed away from your campsite.

Prohibited Items

1. Firearms are prohibited for guests at the Camp Murray Campground other than WMD/National Guard employees with an approved exception. [policy updated Feb 2023 per Office of WAARNG Provost Marshal]
2. Fireworks/pyrotechnics are strictly prohibited on Camp Murray.
3. Marijuana use at the campground is prohibited at the Camp Murray Campground. [policy updated Feb 2023 per Office of the WAARNG Provost Marshal]
4. Unmanned aircraft systems (UAS/Drones) are prohibited at the Camp Murray Campground without prior approval from the Provost Marshal.

Pets

1. Pet(s) must always remain on a leash and be supervised by an adult. Pets tied up outside of the RV may not be on a lead longer than **6 feet**.
2. Pets are not allowed in restrooms, recreation room or the laundry room.
3. Portable pet kennels are allowed, provided they do not encroach on another site or common area.
4. Staff may impound or remove any stray or unattended animal at the owner's expense.
5. You must clean up after your pet. Failure to do so will result in possible eviction.
